

# Gateway Dog Park Rules and Regulations

1. Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injury caused by their dogs.
2. Professional dog walkers, trainers and groomers shall not use the park to conduct their business.
3. Only two dogs per person at any one time.
4. Children under 16 must be under direct supervision of an adult.
5. Owners **MUST** clean up after their pets, by sealing feces in a plastic bag and disposing of it in designated trash receptacles.
6. Dogs with a known history of dangerous behavior are prohibited.
7. Dogs must be vaccinated against distemper and parvovirus, and regularly examined and treated for parasites.
8. Dogs must wear a collar with identification, current dog license and current rabies tag at all times.
9. Puppies under four months of age are prohibited.
10. Dogs must be spayed or neutered.
11. Leaving dogs unattended is prohibited. Owners must closely supervise their dogs at all times.
12. Owners must have a leash readily available at all times.
13. If owner fails to provide water; the liability for pet health falls upon the owner.
14. Do Not bring: food or treats for dogs or humans; glass containers; alcohol; children's toys; or human sports equipment (e.g., football, baseball, soccer ball, skateboards, roller skates/blades etc.) into the park.
15. Owners/custodians of a dog are responsible for the acts and conduct of their animal at all times when it is in a city park. Park users and dog owners assume all risks related to use of the dog parks.
