Sealed proposals/bids will be received by the District Manager at the office of the GATEWAY SERVICES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (DISTRICT), 13240 Griffin Drive, Fort Myers, Florida 33913, as follows:

- Bid Group No: 1 bids will be received until 2:00 P.M., Wednesday, November 28, 2018, at which time and place they will be read aloud.
- Bid Group No: 2 bids will be received until 10:00 A.M., Tuesday, December 4, 2018, at which time and place they will be read aloud.

Note that each Bid Group contains three (3) lake bank improvement projects and that each project shall serve as a stand-alone project, for award of up to six (6) separate projects.

A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting will be held for all interested parties on Thursday, November 15, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. at the District office, for both groupings.

The work for which these proposals are submitted for the DISTRICTS lake Bank Restoration Program consists of providing labor, materials, and equipment for surveying, bank restoration with soil, fabric and stone, installation of drain boxes, submittal of as-built drawings and related work for six lakes within the DISTRICT.

All work performed shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications and Contract Documents pertaining here to which may be examined at the DISTRICT office 13240 Griffin Drive, Fort Myers, Florida 33913, during normal business hours, in compliance with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, permits, development orders and government approvals. Construction and upgrades for the Lake Bank Restoration Program are financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund. The CWSRF program is administered by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection with joint funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

One copy of the documents, including bid forms to be executed and submitted may be obtained at the District Office by request in writing.

A certified or cashier's check drawn on a national or state bank in the State of Florida or a bid bond in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid, made payable to the GATEWAY SERVICES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, shall accompany each bid as a guarantee that the bidder will not withdraw from the competition after opening of bids and, in the event that the contract is awarded

to the bidder, bidder will enter into a contract and furnish the required certificates of insurance and other similar assurances, failing which the bid deposit may be retained by the DISTRICT as liquidated damages.

Proposals/bids shall be prepared, addressed and submitted in compliance with the detailed instructions as set forth in the Contract Documents. The DISTRICT reserves the right to reject any and all bids, with or without cause, to waive technical errors and informalities or to accept the bid which, in its judgement, best serves the DISTRICT.
